ORDER

On March 9, 2007, Continental Electronics Corporation (appellant) timely filed a notice of appeal after its termination proposal was denied by the Broadcasting Board of Governors' contracting officer. Appellant had submitted the proposal after its contract had been terminated for convenience. The appeal was proceeding under the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, 41 U.S.C. §§ 601-613, as amended.
