ORDER

On January 17, 2014, Veterans Development Corporation, Inc. timely filed an appeal concerning task order VA 248-12-J-4157 under its contract, VA248-C-1881, with the Department of Veterans Affairs. The contract involved work to accommodate an MRI unit. The dispute concerns contractor claims for work performed and damages, and agency claims for liquidated damages. A mediation successfully resolved this dispute informally. On October 22, 2014, the Board received a joint stipulation of settlement and motion for dismissal with prejudice. Accordingly, this matter is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
