ORDER

On March 21, 2014, the Board received from Mack Scogin Merrill Elam Architects, Inc. (contractor) a timely-filed notice of appeal concerning its contract, GS-07P-04-UEC-0004, with the General Services Administration (agency). The contractor provided design and other services. The contractor here disputes a decision by the contracting officer which found design deficiencies and assessed a dollar amount due from the contractor to the agency. The parties engaged in mediation and resolved the dispute, with each party to bear its costs and fees. In accordance with a motion for dismissal with prejudice received on December 10, 2014, the Board **DISMISSES WITH PREJUDICE** the appeal.
