ORDER

This is an appeal of a contracting officer's decision on unallowable costs. The decision was issued in July 2011, although the notice of appeal, filed in April 2016, said the appellant first saw the decision in February 2016. In May 2016, the respondent moved to dismiss the appeal for lack of jurisdiction as untimely. The appellant opposed the motion.

On August 15, 2016, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the appeal without prejudice. We grant the motion as a negotiated resolution of the appeal. The Board has made no determination as to its jurisdiction.

The appeal is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.**
