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DECISION OF THE BOARD OF CONTRACT APPEALS

March 29, 2005

Before POLLACK, VERGILIO, and WESTBROOK, Administrative Judges.

Opinion for the Board by Administrative Judge WESTBROOK.

This appeal arises out of Purchase Order No. 43-7C22-4-0011 for janitorial services to Buildings 2, 6 and 7 at the Agricultural Research Service (ARS), Southern Plains Range Research Center in Woodward, Oklahoma, between Fawn Irwin, of Mutual, Oklahoma (Appellant), and ARS, an agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. It was received at the Board November 22, 2004.

The appeal was docketed as a deemed denial of Appellant's claim for \$1,000, the amount by which the Contracting Officer (CO) reduced the contract price to reflect the alleged reduced value of services performed.

Prior to the filing of pleadings, Government counsel informed the Board that the parties had agreed to settle the appeal. On January 7, 2005, the Board received a copy of an executed Settlement Agreement. Appellant has now requested that the appeal be dismissed.

DECISION

Having been settled, the appeal is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
